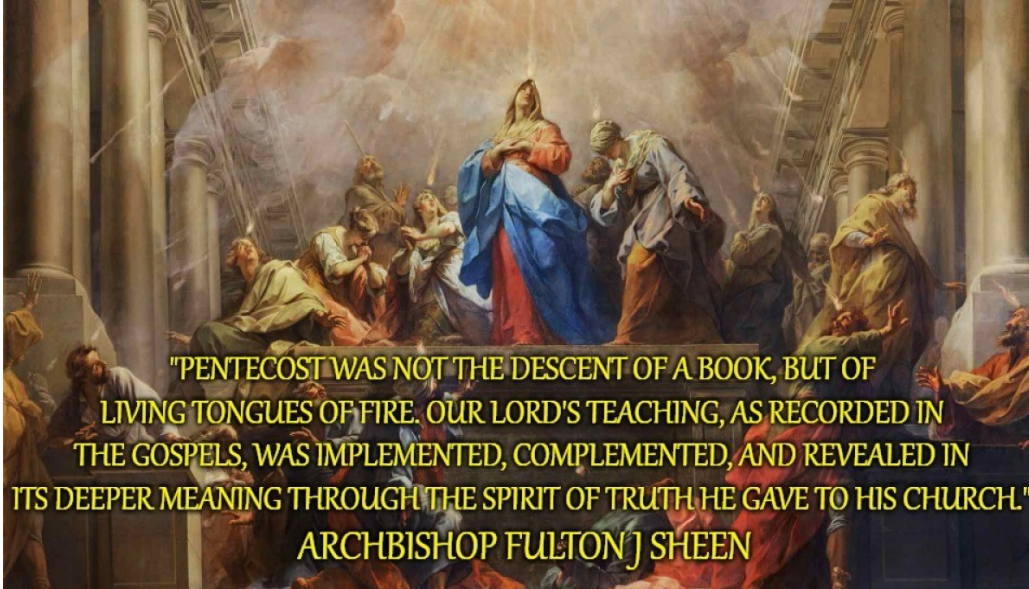

**“Receive the Holy Spirit”**

Today, on Pentecost, the promise of Christ is fulfilled. On the evening of Easter Sunday, the Risen Lord breathed on the Apostles and said, **“Receive the Holy Spirit”** (Jn 20:22). At Pentecost this gift is renewed, made visible, and brought to completion, drawing the entire Paschal mystery to its fullness.

The Holy Spirit creates a new heart in the disciple and builds unity. At Babel, human pride scattered and divided the nations; at Pentecost, the grace of the Spirit gathers and unites. People of many languages understood the Apostles, not because the world had changed, but because the Spirit had transformed the listeners’ hearts. The Spirit is the inner Teacher who leads us into truth, strengthens us to do good, consoles us in suffering, and quietly reshapes us from within. He gives new courage, new desire, and new capacity for holiness.

On the first Pentecost, the Apostles were gathered in prayer with the Virgin Mary. In that atmosphere of silence and openness, the Spirit came: *a sound like a mighty wind*, and *tongues as of fire* resting upon each of them (Acts 2:2–3). Filled with the Holy Spirit, they began to proclaim Christ boldly. Those who had once been fearful became courageous witnesses, unafraid of hardship, persecution, or even martyrdom. The power of the Spirit was alive in them.

The Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Trinity, is the life of our soul and the One who sanctifies us. He dwells within us as the gentle guest of our innermost being. To grow in faith, our relationship with Him must become ever more conscious, personal, and trusting.

On this Pentecost, let us open wide the doors of our hearts, so that the Spirit may renew us, strengthen us, and make us instruments of unity and peace.

## APOSTOLAT POLSKI

### SŁOWO NA NIEDZIELE

Dziś, w uroczystość Zesłania Ducha Świętego, spełnia się obietnica Chrystusa. W wieczór Niedzieli Zmartwychwstania Zmartwychwstały Pan tchnął na Apostołów i powiedział: „**Przyjmijcie Ducha Świętego**” (J 20,22). W dniu Pięćdziesiątnicy ten dar zostaje odnowiony, ukazany w znakach i doprowadzony do pełni, obejmując całe misterium paschalne.

Duch Święty stwarza w uczniu nowe serce i buduje jedność. W Babel ludzka pycha rozproszyła i podzieliła narody; w Pięćdziesiątnicę łaska Ducha gromadzi i jednoczy. Ludzie wielu języków rozumieli Apostołów nie dlatego, że świat się zmienił, lecz dlatego, że Duch przemienił serca słuchających.

Duch jest wewnętrznym Nauczycielem, który prowadzi nas do prawdy, umacnia do czynienia dobra, pociesza w cierpieniu i cicho przemienia nas od wewnątrz. On daje nową odwagę, nowe pragnienie i nową zdolność do świętości.

W pierwszą Pięćdziesiątnicę Apostołowie trwali na modlitwie wraz z Maryją Dziewicą. W tej atmosferze ciszy i otwartości przyszedł Duch: szum jakby gwałtownego wicheru i języki jakby z ognia, które spoczęły na każdym z nich (Dz 2,2–3). Napełnieni Duchem Świętym zaczęli z odwagą głosić Chrystusa. Ci, którzy wcześniej się lękali, stali się odważnymi świadkami, nieustraszonymi wobec trudów, prześladowań, a nawet męczeństwa. Moc Ducha żyła w nich.

Duch Święty, Trzecia Osoba Trójcy Świętej, jest życiem naszej duszy i Tym, który nas uświęca. Mieszka w nas jako łagodny Gość najgłębszego wnętrza. Aby wzrastać w wierze, nasza relacja z Nim musi stawać się coraz bardziej świadoma, osobista i ufna.

W tę uroczystość Zesłania Ducha Świętego otworzymy szeroko drzwi naszych serc, aby Duch mógł nas odnowić, umocnić i uczynić narzędziami jedności i pokoju.

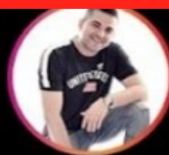

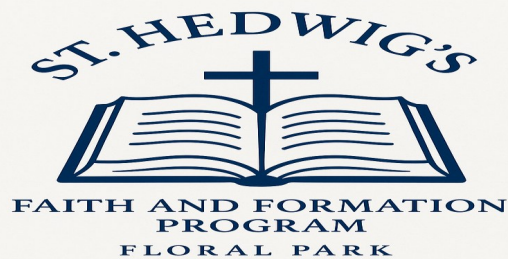
